

***Chief Warrant Officer M.N. Murphy, MMM, CD
SERGENT-MAJOR 12^{ième} Régiment Blindé du Canada***



Chief Warrant Officer Marc Murphy grew up in Rawdon, in the Lanaudière region, and enrolled in the Canadian Armed Forces on June 18, 2003, as an Armour NCM.

After completing his occupational training, he was posted to the 12^e Régiment blindé du Canada (12 RBC), where he successively held various operational positions, including driver, gunner, and crew commander on both the Leopard 2A6M tank and the Coyote reconnaissance vehicle. He took part in several major exercises and deployed to Afghanistan in 2007 as a Corporal, and again in 2010 as a Master Corporal. In 2011, he joined The Royal Canadian Dragoons in Petawawa, where he improved his second language

skills and continued his professional advancement to the rank of Sergeant.

Promoted to Warrant Officer in 2015, he returned to 12 RBC, where he assumed key responsibilities, including during Operation IMPACT in Kuwait and Iraq in 2016. From 2017 to 2020, he held various leadership positions as a Senior Warrant Officer and contributed to domestic operations LENTUS and LASER. In 2020, he was posted to the Canadian Forces Leadership and Recruit School as an instructor.

Promoted to Master Warrant Officer in 2021, he deployed to Amman, Jordan, where he served as the Sergeant Major for the Canadian Training and Assistance Team. From 2022 to December 2023, he returned to 12 RBC in Valcartier as Squadron Sergeant Major for A Squadron, followed by Command and Support Squadron (CS).

In January 2024, he was posted to Ottawa to the Strategic Joint Staff Headquarters. In June 2024, he was assigned as Senior Career Manager for Armour NCMs. In December 2024, he was inducted into the Order of Military Merit.

Promoted to Chief Warrant Officer in April 2026, he was appointed Regimental Sergeant Major of 12 RBC on May 01, 2026.

Chief Warrant Officer Murphy shares his life with his spouse, Mélanie. He is the father of Nathan and stepfather of Colins. Passionate about hunting, golf, and travel, he enjoys outdoor activities during his free time.
